The girls will learn the basic foundation of developing a business plan, and they will participate in workshops on effective study habits, self-esteem building, and community service. Each girl will submit her final business plan to a panel of judges later in the year, which will assist them in gaining confidence to pitch their future ideas to others in the "real" world.
