AMMS Dress Code Policy

Purpose: At AMMS, our uniform policy supports a focused and respectful learning environment. It promotes equity, minimizes distractions, and builds a sense of unity and school pride. By aligning appearance with our high expectations, we help students focus on what matters most—learning, leadership, and belonging.

Please Note: Parents will be informed if their child is out of uniform, and will be asked to bring the proper uniform to the school immediately. If this is not possible, the student will be required to wear a substitute uniform (if available) and will receive a uniform violation.



Tops: Solid navy, yellow, or white collared polo shirts (polo or buttondown).

Bottoms: Khaki, navy, or black uniform-style pants.

Outerwear: Cardigans or sweaters must be **one** solid color with no large logos or labels. Polos must be worn underneath any outerwear, including cardigans and sweaters.

Scholars are not permitted to wear the following:

- Hoodies, regardless of brand or color
- Cargo pants, jeggings, leggings, short skirts,
- Flip flops, open toe shoes
- Spirit Shirts/House shirts worn Monday-Thursday
- Non-collar polos worn Monday-Thursday

Fridays are SPIRIT DAYS

Students may wear their AMMS House or Spirit shirts.

Jeans are allowed as long as they are free of rips, holes, or tears

Getting Started with ParentSquare for Parents and Guardians


Welcome to ParentSquare! This guide will help you activate your account, find helpful resources, and download the free ParentSquare app so you can start receiving updates from your school.

Activate your ParentSquare account

Your school will send you an invitation using your email address or phone number on file.

- Open the invitation from ParentSquare in your email or text messages.
- Click Activate your account or tap the link to go to the account registration page.
- Enter your email or phone number, then click Get Started

(Optional: You can also sign in with Google or Microsoft.)



- Check your contact information. If it looks correct, click Confirm. You'll receive a code by text or email.
- 5. Enter the verification code when asked.
- 6. You'll see your children's names. Click Confirm next to each child who should be connected to your account.
 If a child is listed by mistake, click Not my child.
- 7. If everything looks correct, click **Yes, this is me.**

Now you're ready to start using ParentSquare!







How To Add A Child




Schedule Pickup Changes


Change Default Pickup

Select Default Pickup from this screen to change your child(ren) default pickup mode. The app will prompt a message if the schools have restricted this.




6 Check In

On Check In tab, you will be able to complete the check in for you or your children. Contact App Support if the Check In tab is not available for you.



Announce Your Arrival

The app's Pickup tab allows you to see your children, view their pickup mode, and announce your arrival.



App Support

Go to the Account page (at the bottom of your home screen), and then select "Contact Support". Fill out and submit the form to be connected with a friendly customer service human or email support@pikmykid.com.



How do I add a change to my child's dismissal schedule?

- 1. Choose the child from the children's tab (tap the green icon next to your school's name to make changes for multiple students).
- 2.Choose the applicable calendar date when you want the change to start OR select the three-dot icon on your bottom right corner.
- 3. Select Change Pickup.
 - a. Confirm the start date is correct.
 - b. Select one of the options to repeat the change if applicable and choose the last applicable day to be included.
 - c. Select the desired pickup option from the drop-down. Then select who is picking up.
- 4. Review the Pickup Summary and Confirm Change to save your selection you will see a green notification on the top of the screen with the confirmation of the changes.

How do I announce my arrival to the school?

- 1. Parents can only announce at school, during the set dismissal hours, if the school has the Announce feature enabled on the school portal.
- 2. Make sure your phone's location services are enabled on both your phone and your Pikmykid parent app.
- 3. Stop at the stop sign and select the GREEN ANNOUNCE button on your Pick Up tab.
- * If your school is using the hands-free announcement feature, review the option is enabled on the Account tab and that you have granted the correct location permissions.

How do I manage my delegates?

- 1. Select Account at the bottom of your screen, then select Manage Approved Contacts.
- 2. Select the Create Contact icon (person with a plus sign) to create a new contact. You can also Edit, Delete, or Deactivate delegates as needed by selecting their names. * Inactive delegates will be grayed out and they won't be visible on your list when adding a Delegation to your child's calendar.
- 3. When editing a contact, you can add photos to delegates, mark them as emergency contacts and select their relationship to each child in your app.
- * Note: Delegates are not able to see your child on their app until you assign them to your child's calendar for specific dates.
